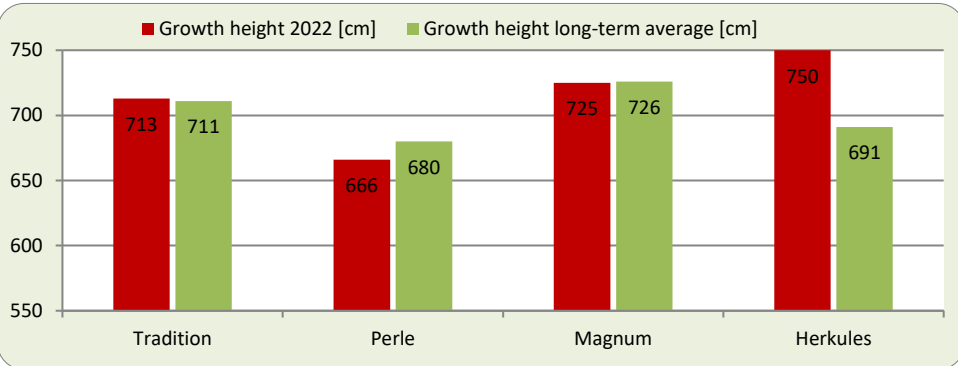
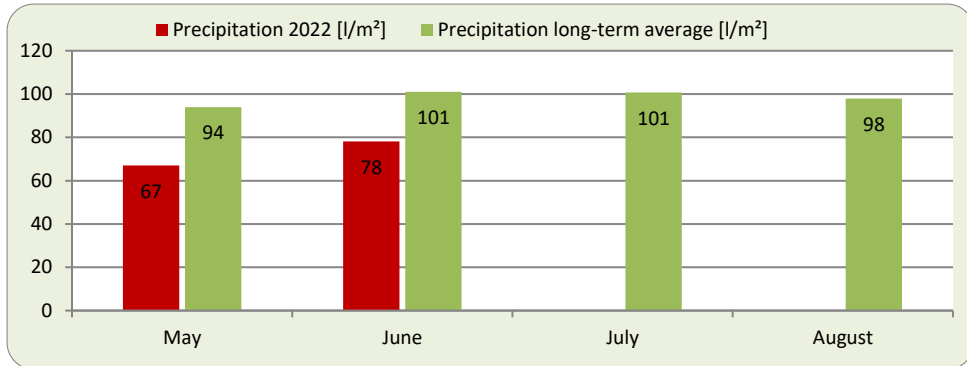
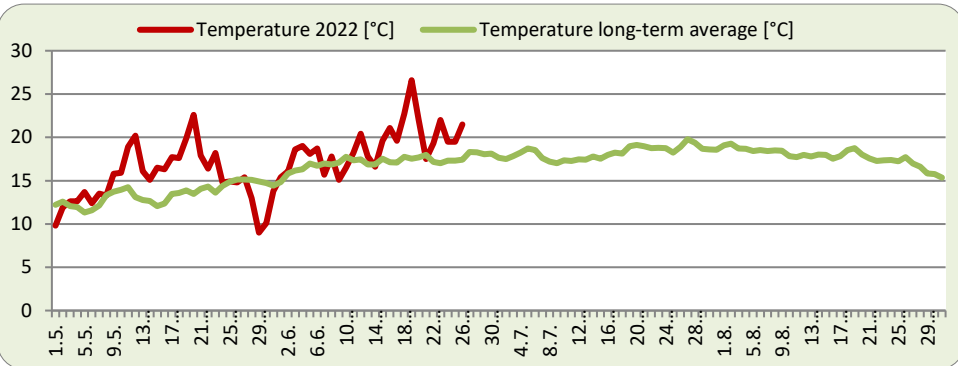


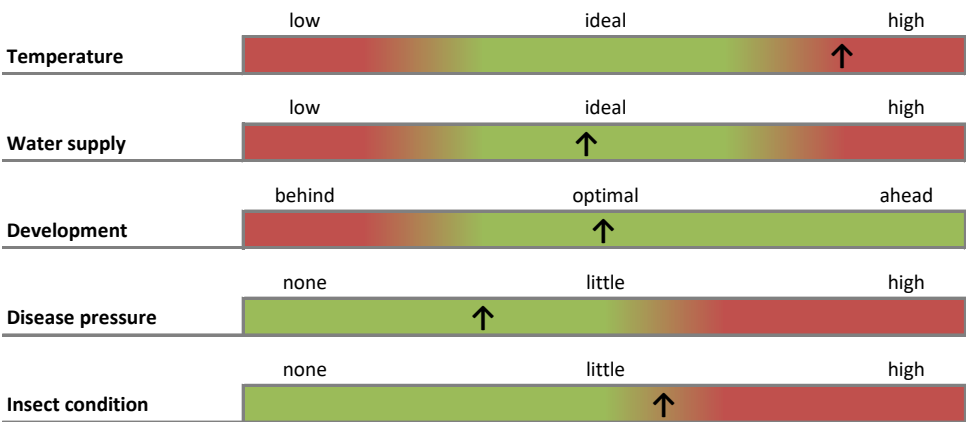
Report on Weather and Hop Growing Conditions: Week 25

Comments: At the beginning of the week, a hailstorm damaged around 1,500 hectares of hop acreage in the southern Hallertau. The damage caused ranged from slight leaf losses up to 100% crop failure. Warm, vigorous summer weather prevailed during the rest of the week, favoring growth, but some Perle fields are a little bit behind in growth. Almost all varieties are already showing the first signs of flowering. Currently, diseases and pests are under control.

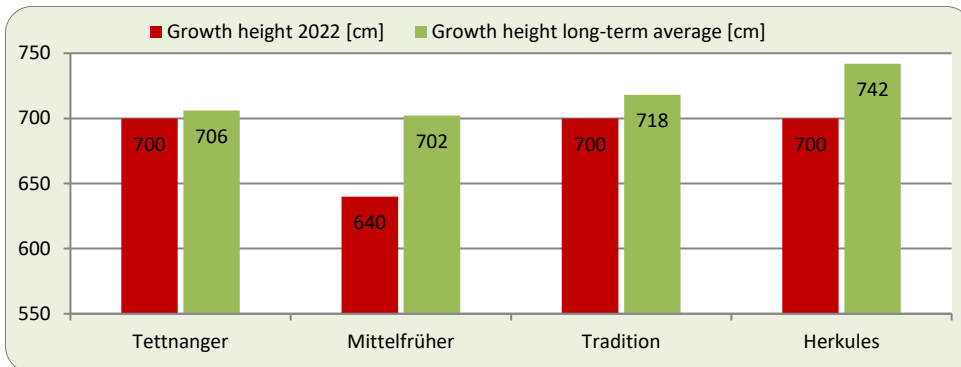
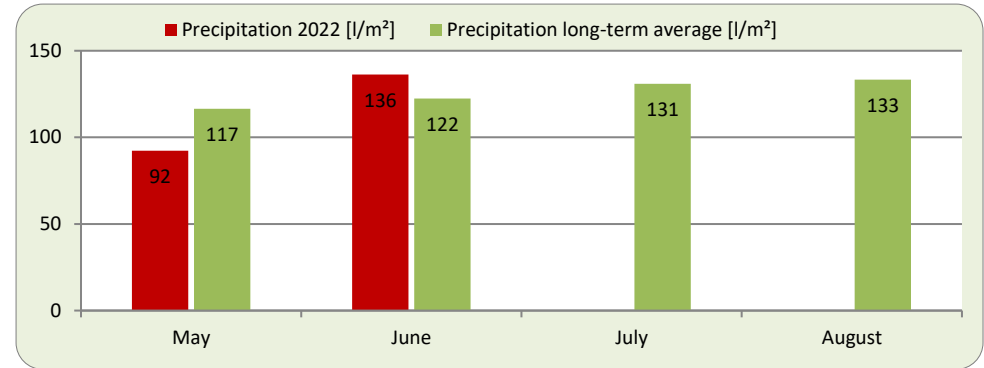
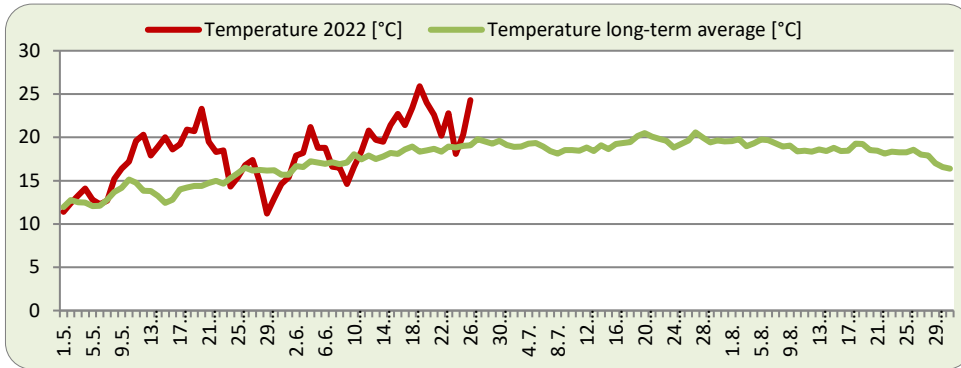

Comments: After a cool start to the week, temperatures rose again to hot summer temperatures. Notable precipitation occurred only in the far east, while drought prevailed in Thuringia and large parts of Saxony-Anhalt. Growers were able to sow catch crops, plowing the rows and started chemical defoliation.
