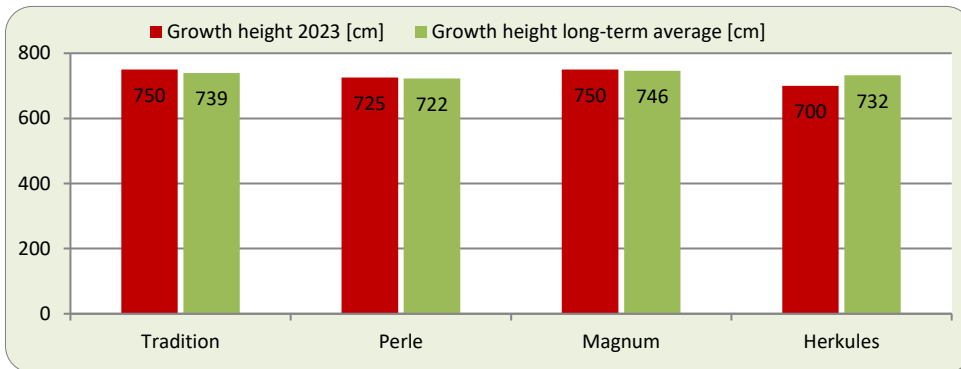
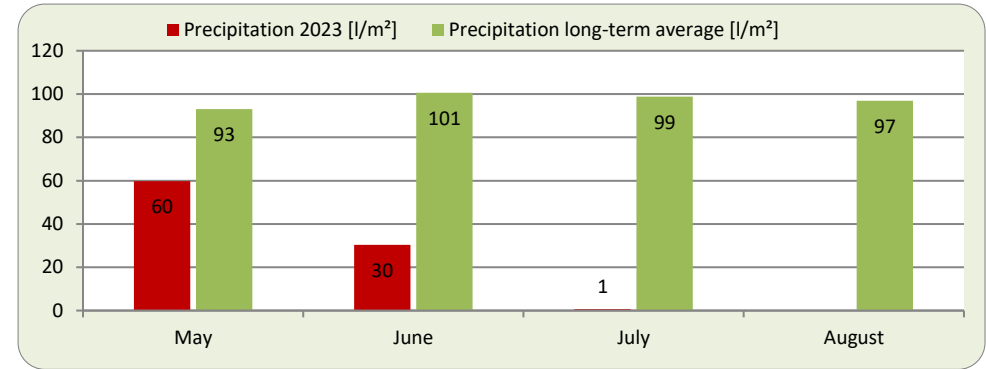
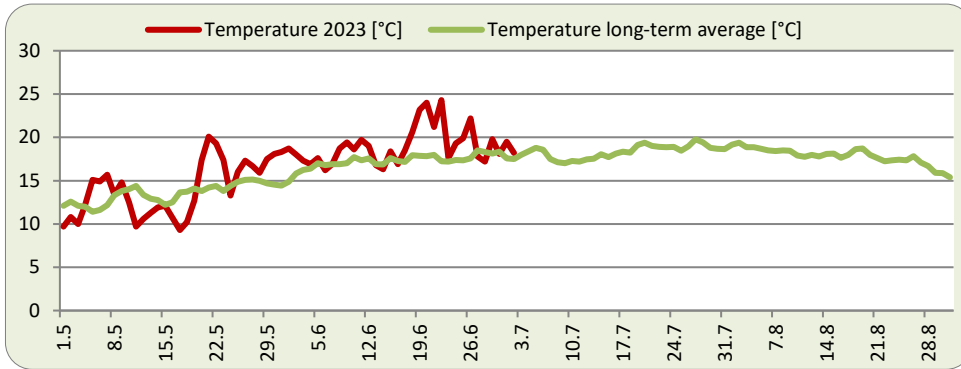


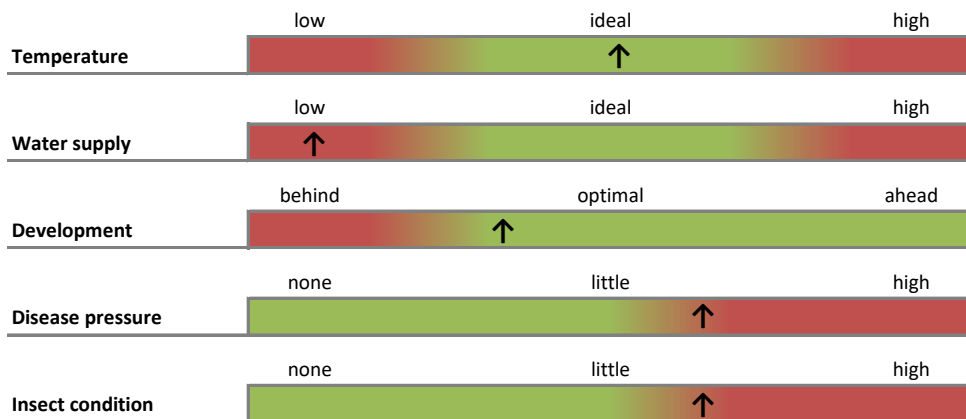
Report on Weather and Hop Growing Conditions: Week 26

Comments: Ideal growing conditions ensured good growth, helped by the now satisfactory water supply to the soils. The first yards have reached trellis height. The farms were busy with fertilizer spreading, chemical hop defoliation and sowing catch crops. Plant protection was applied against downy mildew, powdery mildew, and aphids.
